

Minutes of the Meeting of the Consortium Members, held on January 29, 2007 at ISI, New Delhi at 3 pm.

Major issues that were discussed are follows:

Members discussed issues of joint action plan in Delhi and coordination with Action 2007 of NAPM. It was suggested that consortium should also join trade unions actions when they organise demonstrations, work-shops or rally etc in Delhi on social security of unorganised workers. Mr Subhash Bhatnagar will inform of the action programmes of trade unions to the secretariat of consortium and also to the members well in advance.

It was suggested that the campaign Programme should be intensified in Delhi by hand out distributions, Posters display and post cards to be addressed to the MP of the constituencies by workers. Consortium members will mobilize their own resources for the campaign.

The consortium members may utilize the assistance of their network and support organizations for campaign and other social security issues.

Members also discussed the planning for February and March including the programmes being conducted in states.

Decisions

1. Consortium members resolved to join, support and participate in Action 2007 and in the programmes of Trade Unions on the issues relating to social security of unorganised workers during February and March 2007. Mr Subhash Bhatnagar of NCC-USW will inform of the action programme of trade unions well in advance.
2. It is decided that the three articles which are to be published in the first week of February, as decided in earlier meeting, should be sent to Vijayan, Delhi Forum immediately.
3. Mr Vijayan will inform the consortium members and the secretariat about details of the programmes of Action 2007 (in February-march) in advance so that joint efforts of consortium members may be initiated.
4. It is decided that consortium members will launch an intensive campaign movement as discussed and also inform the secretariat.
5. It is decided that Consortium members will also assist and extend support to the other members in organising the state level conventions being organised in Bhopal, Guwahati, Ranchi, Hyderabad, Chennai , Ahmedabad and in Rajasthan.
6. Consortium members in other states should conduct the state level meetings/ conventions and launch campaign and inform the progress to the secretariat and all support will be made available to them.
