The meeting began with reviewing the progress of the preparations, planning and took stock of the present status. Shri Subash Bhatnagar and J. John gave details of Nagpur visit expressing satisfaction over the preparations being done by NIWCYD Nagpur.

Decisions:

On the issue of participation of NGOs and others the position was not vary clear. It was decided that a database of people who confirm their participation be prepared.

The resource persons confirmation is also vary important. It was decided that all consortium members will actively engage in getting confirmation from resource persons. In this regard NCDHR, CEC, DELHI FORUM and NCC-USW will make efforts and persuasion and appraise the position to secretariat. It was decided that

confirmation from resource persons be obtained on priority. They may be contacted personally.

The design of kit bags was finalised. It was decided that NCC-USW will bear the cost of some of the expenses, it could be the bags. Other members should also bear some cost.

The members should send their papers to the secretariat, in English and in Hindi. The background papers are still to be finalised.

It was decided that a list of representatives who would participate be given to CEC so as to refer them to NIWCYD for inducting them in various committees for arrangements, supervision and to ensure the effectiveness of all programmes.

The background note on various issues to be prepared by consortium members need to be attended on priority. The NCC-USW, NCDHR and ISI representative assured for early completion of papers which will be included in the kit.

The participants also discussed the funding constraints, budget and the finances. Consortium members were advised to raise resources.
